

An estimated 4 million people in low & middle-income countries were receiving antiretroviral therapy (ART) at the end of 2008, compared to 3 million in 2007 & 400,000 in 2003, according to WHO, UNAIDS & UNICEF.

Statistics, by and large, do not cover those taking treatment from private doctors; case-reporting protocols not rigidly followed, confidentiality being the main reason.

Primary care practitioners (General Practitioners, Medical Consultants) have not had an opportunity to imbibe "Art & Science of ART".

We, at CMHF, identify this felt need and have a created a programme that not only teaches but also provides subsequent support, uniform therapy guidelines / MIS and clinic branding.
